

INFORMATION UPDATE

As a result of discussions with DFN Chief & Council, In-SHUCK-ch Nation Interim Government and the BC Treaty Commission, it is agreed that the DFN Information Package is to be updated to ensure accurate information is available prior to the referendum vote January 30, 2010.

Therefore, the updated information is:

- DFN's business arrangements with Cloudworks are protected and will be assured if treaty is ratified.
- DFN's governance system set out in the XA'XTSA Constitution is protected if treaty is ratified.
- DFN's governance and business arrangements are protected by the draft Final Agreement and the draft In-SHUCK-ch Constitution. They remain draft until ratified.
- Enrolment is reversible after the ratification vote; enrolling entitles an individual to In-SHUCK-ch citizenship but accepting In-SHUCK-ch citizenship is a choice.
- After treaty, individuals may trade In-SHUCK-ch Citizenship in favour of Indian Status
